Dear Parent / Carer and Students of Year 13

I am writing to you to inform you about the process of collecting KS5 results from School on Thursday 13th August.

We would very much like students to come into school to collect their results in person if possible, however, we will be guided by Government regulations and local lockdown procedures. If the School is unable to open for results then we will publicise this on our website and social media and send results via the SIMS app which you should already have received information on how to log in.

On Results Day, the students should come in at set times according to their form group. It is important that they only come in at the designated time to ensure that there aren't too many people on site at one time. Students should come into the School via the main entrance by Reception and will leave via the main gate. Unfortunately, due to restrictions placed upon the School due to Covid-19, we will be unable to allow parents into School during results collections.

For GCSE Maths/English retake results, students will need to also come into School on Thursday 20th August at 9.00am to collect these.

Students will be handed their results in an envelope that has been packed by administrators wearing gloves and following strict hygiene guidelines. Once students have been issued their results they will have an opportunity to meet with members of staff including:

- Connexions
- UCAS guidance
- Other next steps guidance
- Student First Team

We are aware that some students may be disappointed with their results this year as they were unable to sit their examinations. Should students wish to sit the examinations for any of their qualifications, there will be a chance for them to apply for this on Results Day.
