Intermediate Mathematical Challenge

As you may already be aware, every year, the UK Mathematics Trust (UKMT) runs a series of competitions for secondary school pupils to encourage them to develop their love of solving problems.

Solving problems is a key element of the new Mathematics GCSE and participation in these competitions is actively encouraged.

This year, The Buckingham School would like to widen access to the competitions such that more pupils can experience using their knowledge, mathematical reasoning, precision of thought, and fluency to solve interesting problems - and gain an idea of how their solutions compare to a national benchmark.

The Intermediate Mathematical Challenge is the UKMT competition for pupils in Year 9 and Year 10 and based on their progress and attitude to learning, your child has been selected to be offered an opportunity to enter the competition.

All pupils who enter the UKMT Intermediate Mathematical Challenge will receive a certificate of participation for taking part and the highest scoring pupils may earn a bronze, silver or gold award; with the very best possibly being selected to be entered for the international stage. The UKMT itself marks the Challenge papers, determines which pupils have earned the awards and which are put forward to compete for the UK at one of the two possible International levels (Kangaroo or Olympiad). These can, hence, be seen as valuable independent evidence of attitude and ability when applying for 6th Form and University.

In order for your child to take part, we are asking parents to make a small voluntary contribution of £2.00, to cover the cost of the papers plus the administration process. We hope you will agree it is of huge benefit taking part in this prestigious annual competition - and a chance at potentially earning an award - or even representing the UK at an international level.

The Buckingham School is concerned that every student should have the opportunity to attend school activities/obtain equipment, regardless of their financial circumstances. As such, it may be possible to subsidise those students who would otherwise be unable to attend trips/purchase items.
