## **School Transport**

I am writing to inform you of changes that have been made to some School Transport bus timetables.

As you may be aware, we have been experiencing ongoing issues with buses persistently arriving late at school, which is having an even bigger impact on students' learning, since the amendments to the school day.

With effect from Monday 30<sup>th</sup> January, the bus routes operated by Langston and Tasker will be adjusted as outlined on the next page. If your child's bus number does not appear, it means that the times are staying the same and no further action is required.

These changes have been made in response to feedback received from parents and staff, as well as an analysis of current traffic patterns and travel times. We understand this may cause some inconvenience, but we believe that the benefits of ensuring timely arrival for all students outweigh any inconvenience.

We ask that all students be at their designated bus stop at least five minutes prior to their new scheduled pick-up time in order to ensure that the buses run on schedule.
