On Friday 15th October, there will be an opportunity for all students in Year 12 studying Geography to visit Stowe School for the day. We have been invited to participate in a Student Conference about Climate Change.

The day will be packed with interesting and thought-provoking sessions round this subject. There will be a speech by Sir Ed Davey MP, as well as workshops on topics such as ocean plastics and reducing carbon emissions. They should bring a refillable water bottle and/or refillable coffee mug for use throughout the day. There will be water stations and tea and coffee available throughout the event as well as snacks.
