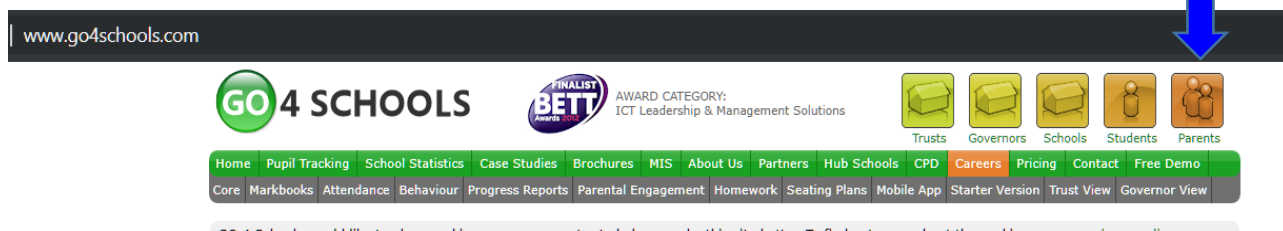
Last term, we provided parents with access to our online Management Information System – ‘Go 4 Schools’. We want to continue to develop our parental communication and establish our culture of transparency.

The online system will enable parents to have 24/7 access to your child’s assessment data, attendance record, behaviour information and progress reports. It will ensure that parents can be much more involved in your child’s school life and their progress at The Buckingham School.

Parents are encouraged to view and celebrate positives rewards and embrace the house system. The system can initiate the important learning conversations we want parents to be involved in.

Below are the instructions on how access the site for the first time. Please follow the instructions carefully:

1. Go to www.go4schools.com in any browser.
2. Click on the “Parents” icon at the top right hand side of the screen:



3. This will take you to the log in screen. Click on the “First-time User?” link:

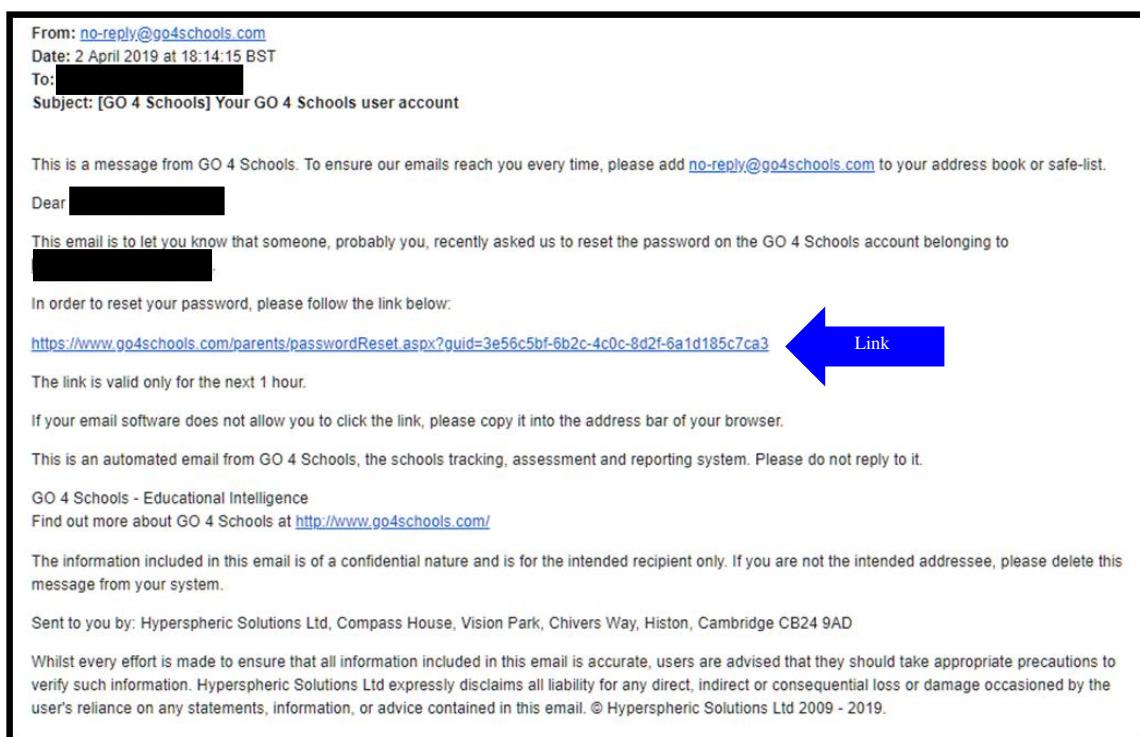


