School Skirts

As the Student Council, we represent students within the School and do our best to resolve any issues that they may have.

Recently, we have been discussing school skirts as the current skirt was ill fitting and not suitable for all body types. As the Student Council, we decided to find a more suitable skirt for students to wear comfortably. We found that many general clothes stores did not sell appropriate school skirts, therefore, we went back to T Kings, our uniform supplier, and asked if they had any other styles available.

T Kings were able to give us seven different skirts to sample and, after asking a range of students for their thoughts, we were able to select three suitable skirts.

As of the next academic year, these three skirts will be the only skirts accepted by the School. Obviously, trousers will continue to be acceptable. All new skirts must be purchased from T Kings and, as of January 2020, all current skirts must be replaced by one of the regulation skirts, the only exception being our Year 11 students who will be able to continue wearing their current school skirt, in line with our existing school uniform policy, until they leave us following their GCSE exams.
