GCSE GEOGRAPHY FIELD TRIP - AMERSHAM RIVER STUDY Monday 30 September 2019 Mrs V Fullwood and Mrs J Wilkinson

We are writing to inform you of an upcoming GCSE Geography field trip on Monday 30 September 2019, at the River Wye in Amersham.

Students will be investigating the changes in river channel shape and discharge at two contrasting sites along the River Wye. They are required to collect their own data through field sketches, measuring width, depth and velocity. We will be visiting two sites along the river. We will be completing this fieldwork with the help of the Field Studies Council that are based in Amersham.

The fieldwork is an essential part of the students' GCSE Geography course and will be examined in the Paper 1 and 2 exams, Summer 2020.

The cost of the trip is £40.00 per student which is necessary to cover the School Field Centre fee, coach journey and insurance and should be paid via ParentMail by Thursday 18 July 2019. Parental consent forms must also be completed and returned to the Payment Box during break or lunchtime, again by Thursday 18 July 2019.

Please dress appropriately for the weather conditions on the day. Please make sure students bring wellies and an extra set of clothing in case of emergency. They should also bring a packed lunch, snacks and plenty to drink. If your child in receipt of Free School Meals, a packed lunch will be provided for them.
