### ROMEO AND JULIET AT THE BUCKINGHAM SCHOOL THURSDAY, 21 MARCH 2019

The school is organising an in-house workshop and performance of Shakespeare's Romeo and Juliet on Thursday, 21 March, as an integral part of your child's GCSE course and exam preparation.

Romeo and Juliet, which is a tragedy written by William Shakespeare early in his career, about two young star-crossed lovers whose deaths ultimately reconcile their feuding families. It was among Shakespeare's most popular plays during his lifetime and is one of his most frequently performed plays. Romeo and Juliet has been adapted numerous times for stage, film, musical, and opera venues. This opportunity will also give our Year 11 students the chance to experience first-hand a performance of Romeo and Juliet which is intended to further support their understanding of the play in performance.
