## Year 12 Duke of Edinburgh Gold Award 2018-2019

The Buckingham School is offering Year 12 students a fantastic opportunity to take part in The Duke of Edinburgh Gold Award scheme. This is a highly esteemed award, which is looked upon favourably by universities and future employers as it allows participate to gain new skills and experience, which include:

- Increased Self-confidence and self-reliance
- A sense of achievement and of responsibility
- Development of leadership skills and abilities
- Improved communication skills
- A real-life demonstration of determination, commitment and resilience
- Improved team work.

The Duke of Edinburgh Gold Award has five sections, as outlined in the graphic opposite:

Participants will also plan, train for and complete a 4-day (3 night) expedition twice, one as a practice and one for their final qualifying expedition. The expedition will be done through an external expedition company – BXM Expeditions.

They will provide further guidance, support and information nearer the expedition time. We are hoping to arrange the expeditions in the Summer term 2019. Please note that a member of School staff will not accompany students on this.



## Cost

If your son/daughter would like to undertake the Duke of Edinburgh Gold Award, there is a non-refundable fee of £40 to enrol: payable by all students which includes the Welcome registration pack from DofE (£28) and the remainder is school enrolment and administration costs. This cost does not cover the cost of the expeditions which will come out later in the school year. These are approximately £350 per student to cover both expedition trips (Practise and Qualifying), qualified staff, campsite fees, all training, group equipment (tents, trangias) and insurance for both expeditions. Payment for this will be made direct to the expedition company – BXM Expeditions.
