To celebrate their hard work and outstanding effort this year, we will be running a Sports Leaders Beach Trip to Newquay, Cornwall from Monday 15th July to Friday 19 July 2019, as part of our Enrichment week at The Buckingham School.

Students will depart from The Buckingham School at 6.30am on Monday and return to school at approximately 3.00pm on the Friday. They will be transported to Newquay by school mini bus and will be accompanied by myself and Mr Ribbans at all times.
