We are very pleased and proud to publish our Ofsted report to the community.

Given our journey as a school, we are delighted to have been reaffirmed as a Good School and to have received recognition for many improvements that have been made. Given our passion for the students' entitlement to be safe and to feel safe, it is a point of huge satisfaction to have The Buckingham School recognised for its stance on bullying and for even further improved standards of behaviour. The students universally reported that the few cases of bullying are rapidly and fully dealt with.

In the feedback received directly from the Ofsted Lead Inspector, the Governors and Local Authority representatives heard for themselves that students, parents and staff strongly voiced in their interviews and questionnaires that the School has improved significantly in the last two years. Year 11 students told the Inspectors that they wished that the Headteacher had been in the post longer!

At The Buckingham School, leaders wear their hearts on their sleeves. Our commitment to the School's mission is total. We care so much about our community and the mission is that Success is for All. Is The Buckingham School good enough? Probably, yes it is, but not by our standards. Not for these students.
