GCSE GEOGRAPHY FIELD TRIP - AMERSHAM RIVER STUDY
TUESDAY 12 FEBRUARY 2019: 11A MRS PYKETT
WEDNESDAY 13 FEBRUARY 2019: 11D MRS WILKINSON

We are writing to inform you of an upcoming GCSE Geography field trips on Tuesday, 12 and Wednesday, 13 February 2019, at the River Wye in Amersham.

Students will be investigating the changes in river channel shape and discharge at two contrasting sites along the River Wye. They are required to collect their own data through field sketches, measuring width, depth and velocity. We will be visiting two sites along the river. We will be completing this fieldwork with the help of the Field Studies Council that are based in Amersham.

The fieldwork is an essential part of the students' GCSE Geography course and will be examined in the Paper 1 and 2 exams this Summer.

As this trip forms part of the curriculum, your child's participation will be paid for from his/her Pupil Premium allocation to cover school field centre fee, coach journey and insurance. Parental consent forms should be completed, however, and returned to the Payment Box during break or lunchtime by **Monday, 4 February 2019** or as soon as possible.

Students must wear suitable clothing on the day including wellies and an extra set of clothing in case of emergency. They should also bring a packed lunch, snacks and plenty to drink. Please dress appropriately for the weather conditions on the day.

The return time is approximate due to traffic considerations but we will endeavour to be back on time for the school bus.
