**High School Musical Theatre Production
Troubadour Theatre, Wembley
19th November 2026, 11:00 - 18:00**

The Performing Arts Department is delighted to be organising a trip to London for students taking part in our school production of *High School Musical Jr.* to see a live stage production of *High School Musical*, starring Harry Judd.

As the production has a limited run, we are keen for our students to experience a professional performance before staging their own show in December. We hope this opportunity will inspire and excite them, while providing valuable insight into the music, choreography, characterisation, and staging of the production, helping to enrich their own performances and deepen their understanding of musical theatre.

The cost of this trip including transportation, administration and insurance is £65. Places are limited, but we have secured 30 places.

If you would like your child to go on this trip, please secure their place by paying a non-refundable deposit of £30 via ParentMail by 6th July 2026.

To locate the trip in ParentMail, once logged in, from the main menu select Payments then "Shop" (shopping trolley icon) and you will find the trip listed here. If you have updated to the new version of ParentMail, from the Main Menu select Accounts and Products, then Products, and the trip will be listed here.

Your child's place will be confirmed in writing and the remaining balance of £35 will then need to be paid, also via ParentMail, by 31st October 2026.

You will be sent a Trip / Medical Consent Form via email from Buckinghamshire Council (please check your spam folder in case it is delivered there) 21 days prior to the trip date; please ensure this is completed and submitted also by 31st October 2026. Your child will not be able to take part in this trip if we have not received this consent form and payment in full.

Please ensure you read the Parental Agreement that has been along with this letter. You will be asked to agree to this in the Trip / Medical Consent Form.

Students are not required to wear full school uniform and should bring a drink, a snack for break time and a packed lunch. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, a packed lunch will be provided for them.

There will also be a safety briefing on 18th November in P2 at 10:40 for all students selected for the trip.

The Buckingham School is committed to ensure that every student should have the opportunity to attend school activities/obtain equipment, regardless of their financial circumstances. As such, it may be possible to subsidise those students who would otherwise be unable to attend trips/purchase items.
