Trip to Warner Bros Studio, Watford

We are delighted to inform you that we are planning a trip to Warner Bros Studios on 11th December 2025. This trip is open to students in Years 10 -13 who are studying Film Studies. The primary purpose of the trip is to provide enrichment opportunities while enhancing our students' understanding of cinematography and screenplay writing in the film industry.

The cost of this trip including transportation, administration and insurance is £48.00. Places are limited, but we have secured 40 places.

15:30 - Coach departs Warner Bros Studio

16:30 - Arrive back at The Buckingham School

If you would like your child to go on this trip, please secure their place by paying a non-refundable deposit of £24.00, via ParentMail, by Monday 22nd September.

To locate the trip in ParentMail, once logged in, from the main menu select Payments and you will find the trip listed here. If all places have been allocated, you will have the opportunity to join the waiting list and you will be contacted should a place become available.

Your child's place will be confirmed in writing and the remaining balance of £24.00 will then need to be paid, also via ParentMail, by Monday 3rd of November. Should you have any issues accessing this site, please contact our Finance Team by emailing finance@buckinghamschool.org.

You will be sent a Trip / Medical Consent Form via email from Buckinghamshire Council (please check your spam folder in case it is delivered there) 21 days prior to the trip date; please ensure this is completed and submitted by Monday 8th December. Your child will not be able to take part in this trip if we have not received this Consent Form and payment in full.

Please ensure you read the Parental Agreement that has been sent along with this letter. You will be asked to agree to this in the Trip / Medical Consent Form.

Students are not required to wear full school uniform and should bring a drink, a snack for break time and a packed lunch. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, a packed lunch will be provided for them.

The Buckingham School is committed to ensure that every student should have the opportunity to attend school activities/obtain equipment, regardless of their financial circumstances. As such, it may be possible to subsidise those students who would otherwise be unable to attend trips/purchase items.
