





Animal Antics

Meet a hedgehog up close, plus some of our permanent resident animals. These residents are unable to return to the wild but play an important role in helping us to inspire and educate visitors about the importance of protecting British wildlife.
	Day Two - Chessington World of Adventures This theme park is not all about adrenaline packed rides (although you can if you want to!). Chessington Zoo and Sea Life has been home to over 1,000 exotic animals for nearly 100 years! With lots to see and do across the park, there is something for everyone. Please be aware of the early departure time for this day!
	Day Three - Woburn Safari Park A trip around the enclosures led by one of the Woburn rangers will show you lions, elephants, giraffes and many others! Explore the open parklands and come face-to-face with lots of exciting wildlife!

FAQ's

Question / Query	Answer
Can my child change activity?	Only in exceptional circumstances can students be transferred between activities (including payments).
	Appeals to change must be submitted in writing to enrichmentweek@buckinghamschool.org for consideration by the school Business Manager/Headteacher but are not guaranteed.
Can I get a refund?	Deposits are non refundable and paying a deposit is a commitment to adhere to the outlined payment plan.
	If a refund is requested and approved, any administration/cancellation charges will be taken from any refund due, over and above the non-refundable deposit.
Can I use Pupil Premium to cover cost?	Pupil Premium support cannot be used to pay the non-refundable deposit.
	PP support to help with the cost of the remaining balance can be requested via finance@buckinghamschool.org but is not guaranteed.
Can I take my child out of school instead?	The dates of Enrichment Week 2026 are part of the school year and therefore, it is a requirement that all students are registered daily. Normal absence procedures must be followed. Taking your child out of school will be treated as an unauthorised absence.
Can my child change their activity to be with their friend?	Changes to activities will not be granted based on social circumstances and relationships. We politely suggest students discuss with their peers before committing to an activity, as once a deposit has been paid, we cannot accommodate any further changes, unless in exceptional circumstances.
My child is undecided on which activity to choosel do not want to pay a deposit for an activity	Students will have 2 weeks to review the activities available and discuss amongst their friends.
	Any student who does not reserve a place on an offsite Enrichment Activity will be automatically placed on the Onsite Carousel.
they are unsure of, only to lose it once they have made up their mind	If, after the deposit payment date closes, there are spaces remaining on any of the offsite activities, these will be advertised to those students allocated to the Onsite Carousel event only. We cannot extend any paid activity beyond the numbers advertised, as the activity prices are based on transport, minimum tickets/event costs and staffing.

Terms and Conditions

- 1. To secure your child a space on an activity, you must make your selection via ParentMail and pay any required non-refundable deposit when the items are released on ParentMail. There is limited availability for each event and once committed, cannot be transferred from one event to another, or refunded. If your child's preferred option has reached maximum capacity, it will show as "Sold Out" on ParentMail. Where this is the case, an alternative activity must be selected.
- 2. Pupil Premium support **cannot be** used for the non-refundable deposit; further financial support towards the remaining balance can be requested via finance@buckinghamschool.org but support is not guaranteed.
- 3. In the event that the minimum number of students required for an event is not met, the Enrichment activity will be cancelled. Parents will be notified as soon as possible, refunded and opportunities of alternative activities offered.
- 4. The dates of Enrichment activities fall within the academic calendar and therefore, it is a requirement that all students are registered daily. Normal absence procedures must be followed and absences reported in accordance with standard procedure.
- 5. Submitting a deposit is a commitment to adhere to the outlined payment plan; failure to maintain payments will result in your child being removed from the activity register and placed on the Onsite Carousel activity. You will be refunded any monies paid less the non-refundable deposit and any additional administration/cancellation charges.
- 6. Only in exceptional circumstances will students be permitted to change activities. Requests to change must be submitted in writing to enrichmentweek@buckinghamschool.org for consideration by the School Business Manager/Headteacher, but are not guaranteed to be approved.
- 7. In extenuating circumstances (for example bereavement/medical reasons), the School will aim to accommodate a student in a more suitable activity. In this situation, a review of payments and suitability for refund will be made by the School Business Manager/Headteacher.
- 8. All students are expected to abide by our Code of Conduct and behave appropriately as representatives of our school. If a student is later deemed a significant safeguarding risk to themselves or others and therefore, cannot partake in the activity, you will be refunded any monies paid less the non-refundable deposit and any additional administration/cancellation charges.
- 9. All Edulink One accounts must have a minimum of two different contact numbers for use in the event of an emergency. You must check your Edulink One account to ensure the information held is correct. Your child may not be able to part in any offsite activity if we do not have at least two emergency contact numbers on file for each student.
- 10. For all activities taking place offsite, you will be required to complete a Consent Form which will be emailed to you via Buckinghamshire Council on Friday 26th June 2026. Please check your junk/spam email in case it is delivered there. This must be completed and submitted by Friday 3rd July 2026. Your child will not be allowed to participate in the offsite activity if we have not received your completed form.
- 11. Some of the venues we plan to visit may require their own additional consent to be given for your child to participate. Failure to comply with any such request may result in your child being removed from the that specific activity. In the event of this happening, you will be refunded monies paid for this element of the overall cost, less the non-refundable deposit and any additional administration/cancellation charges.
