Past Exam Papers: A mock exam is scheduled to take place in March 2013. For entries prior to this date mock exams will be completed in a combination of class work and homework. It is imperative that students work through these thoroughly. Additional questions from past papers are available in the Maths area of the VLE.

Mymaths.co.uk: This website contains help and support for students on all aspects of the course. As a guide, students should be working on at least two topics from the booster pack each week ensuring that they get a "green light" on each. They then can go through them again with an aim of achieving 100% on each.
