Enrichment Week 22nd-24th May 2023: International Cooking on a Budget

Further to the notification via ParentMail, I am delighted to confirm that you child has been selected to participate in the exciting International Cooking on a Budget 3-day event.

Please be informed that this event will take place onsite, supervised by School staff. Normal break and lunchtime arrangements, as well as school buses, will remain in place. If your child would usually bring a packed lunch, buy from the canteen or receive free school meals, they should continue to do so as normal.

Students will be provided with everything they need for the three days, except for containers to take the food home in. Please make sure that students have the correct size container for each product being made and bring a large carrier bag to carry food home. All containers and bags should be labelled with the student's name. Please let me know as soon as possible if your child has any food allergies or dietary requirements.

The itinerary for this event, along with details of the types and sizes of containers required, is set out below:

Monday - Mexican

Salsa: - please provide a small plastic container with lid Enchiladas: - please provide a 2ltr oven proof dish Key lime pie: - we will provide a foil dish

Tuesday - Indian

Chicken or vegetable curry: - large airtight container

Naan Bread: - we will wrap

Apple Samosa: - medium container with closing lid

Wednesday - Italian

Focaccia Bread: - we will wrap

Lasagne: - please provide a 2ltr oven proof dish

Tiramisu: - we will provide a foil dish

Students will be provided with an apron which they will be able to take home after the event.

Safety and hygiene procedures are as follows:

- No excessive makeup
- No jewellery as it tends to get lost
- Hair tied back
- No nail varnish, false nails or acrylic nails
- No excessively high shoes
