Year 11 Geography Fieldwork

As you are aware, summer exams are nearly upon us. Part of the GCSE Geography course involves an element of fieldwork. In order for our Year 11 students to be fully prepared for their upcoming GCSE Geography exam, myself and another member of staff will be taking each Geography group out of the classroom to complete both sections of our fieldwork studies across the local area on Tuesday and Wednesday next week.

Although the School will be closed to many students due to the industrial action taking place on Tuesday 2nd May, your child, along with all other Year 11 students, are required to attend School on this day, as communicated in a letter from the Headteacher earlier this week.
