Dear Parent / Carer,

Enrichment Week 22nd-24th May 2023: A Life of Leisure

Further to the notification via ParentMail, I am delighted to confirm that your child has been selected to participate in the exciting 'A Life of Leisure' 3-day event.

Please be advised that all activities for this event will be offsite, supervised by School staff. Students should continue to follow their normal drop off/pick up arrangements from School for all three days of the event; arrival each morning must be prompt to ensure a smooth and swift departure.

You will shortly receive a Trip/Medical Consent Form via email from a company called Evolve; please ensure this is completed and submitted by Friday 12th May 2023. Your child will not be able to take part in this event if we have not received the consent form.

All students are to report to H3 each morning at 8:30am for registration and daily briefing.

The itinerary for this event is set out below:

- Monday:** Urban Battlefields – laser tag tournament. A packed lunch is needed for this day. The Urban Battlefields venue requires all parents / carers to complete and submit their own waiver form in order for your child to participate in activities. This form has been sent to you along with this letter and will require printing in order for you to fill it in. Completed forms must be returned to the 'Parent Permissions and Payments' that is on the wall opposite the stairs in the Jubilee building by Friday 12th May 2023. This form is in addition to completing the Consent Form from Evolve. If you have any issues printing this form, a hardcopy can be made available for you to collect from our main Reception.
- Tuesday:** Mr Mulligan's Pirate Golf (outdoor), lunch at Xscape and Planet Ice. Students have the option to bring money to purchase lunch at Xscape, or to bring a packed lunch to eat whilst there.
- Wednesday:** Tenpin Northampton, followed by Boost Trampoline Park. Lunch will be provided at Boost following the trampolining session, at no extra cost.

Your child will be outside for most of the day on Monday 22nd May and in the morning of Tuesday 23rd May, therefore, please ensure that your child has suitable clothing, sunscreen and plenty of water. All outdoor activities will continue to take place even in inclement conditions.

All of the activities require participants to wear comfortable, loose-fitting clothing and sensible shoes. Trainers would be ideal. Please ensure that your child is suitably clothed for the activities.

As a reminder, payment for this event is now due, via ParentMail. Please can I ask this is paid no later than Friday 12th May, to ensure we can be fully prepared for the event.
