Sixth Form Students
BUSINESS DRESS
Tailored suit trousers, skirt or dress; strictly no lycra, clingy skirts or dresses Skirt and dress lengths must be no more than 8 cm above the knee Suit jackets are optional, however coats must be removed in lessons
Buttoned shirt with collar (long or short sleeved), blouse or smart top For shirts - Top buttons must be fastened, shirt tucked into trousers and ties should be worn
A smart jumper may be worn, with a small discreet logo No oversized jumpers or hooded sweatshirts, or jumpers with large logos may be worn
Shoes must be formal in style, smart in appearance and either flat or low heeled in accordance with health and safety considerations No UGG boots, Air Force 1's, Converse, Vans, trainers, plimsolls, flip-flops or other open-toed shoes are to be worn
Jewellery should be discreet with limited piercings
Student Identity Lanyard must be worn at all times
