## Enrichment Week 22<sup>nd</sup>-24<sup>th</sup> May 2023 3D Art and Photography

Further to the notification via ParentMail, I am delighted to confirm that you child has been selected to participate in the exciting 3D Art and Photography 3-day event.

The Event has been organised to introduce students to some of the basics of 3D Art design and Photography and will comprise of fun practical activities that involve the application of paper mache, 3D construction, texture, application of paint plus the use of the DSLR camera and studio.

Please be informed that this event will take place on and offsite, supervised by School staff. Timings to the start and end of the School day remain unchanged and normal break and lunchtime arrangements, as well as school buses, will remain in place. If your child would usually bring a packed lunch, buy from the canteen or receive free school meals, they should continue to do so as normal.

All students are to report to A3 each morning at 8:30am for registration and daily briefing.

The itinerary for this event is set out below:

Monday:	3D Art Construction
Tuesday:	Photography Trip: Theme Colour
Wednesday:	Completion of 3D/Photography Art piece and Awards Presentation

A photography trip into Buckingham town has been organised for Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> May. The trip will take the route of 'Berties Walk' then on to Buckingham University area, then St Peter's & St Paul's Church, The Old Quarter and finally 'Cornwalls Meadow' before heading back to School. Students will be accompanied by School staff.

Students are welcome to bring their own cameras (if they prefer) for use during the three days and the responsibility for looking after them remains with the students. However, all photoshoots are organised in pairs, and each pair will be given a department DSLR camera to use each day.

Students need to wear comfortable, practical clothes and sturdy flat shoes or trainers each day. They may also wish to bring an old shirt or apron to wear when painting. Please also ensure you child wears suitable outdoor clothing and sunscreen if necessary and brings a bag/backpack to use on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> April as we will be out and about in Buckingham!

At the end of the three days, there will be a small presentation to celebrate students' finished 3D/Photography construction achievements.
