Student Exam Timetables

All students sitting exams this summer now have access to their individual timetable through our new system Edulink One. Students were all given login details for this before Easter and should be able to see the most up to date version of their timetable by logging in. Whilst students will obtain the latest information about their exam timetable from the system, we will supply them with a paper copy of their exam timetable.

It is imperative that students know the start time of their exams. All morning exams will start promptly at 9.00am and afternoon exams will either start at 1.00pm or 1.30pm, depending on the length of the exam. This is to ensure that students who get the bus home can still do this.

Results Days

Results days this year are as follows:

- Thursday 18th August - A level and Level 3 results
- Thursday 25th August - GCSE and Level 2 results

Students will be able to collect their results between 9.00am and 12.00pm on each of these days.

Students must collect their results in person; they cannot be released to anyone else without prior consent. If students are unable to collect their results in person, they may either give permission for someone to collect them on their behalf, or they may have their results emailed to them.

In either instance, students themselves must email exams@buckinghamschool.org directly, to either give permission for a nominated person to collect their results or to confirm that they would like their results emailed to them. Due to GDPR, we cannot accept requests from parents / carers.
