### Year 10 Health and Social Care BTEC Coursework Submission Date Friday 25<sup>th</sup> March 2022

I am writing to advise that your child is currently working on their Health and Social Care Component 1 Learning Aim B coursework element.

The final deadline for submission is Friday 25<sup>th</sup> March 2022. This is work that will go towards their final grade in the Health and Social Care BTEC.

As per BTEC regulations, any work that is submitted after this date will not be eligible for a resubmission and therefore, the maximum grade that can be achieved is a Pass.

Work that is submitted on time may be eligible for resubmission. Students will be informed whether their work is eligible for resubmission via their feedback. A resubmission would mean that if your child is working towards a higher grade, they have 15 days to make improvements and resubmit to try and achieve this higher grade.

Where no work is submitted at all, this will result in a fail for this component of the course.

Students will have had 6 hours of lesson time to complete this work; after this, it is expected for them to complete this work independently at home if required. Lunch time sessions will be running every Monday lunchtime to help support students in completing this work, where there will be Chromebooks provided for use. They also have access to support material on Google Classroom, their textbooks and notes from classwork and they are also allowed to use the internet for research purposes.
