Exam Results Days – August 2026

The dates when your results will be available are as follows:

Thursday 13th August - A Level

Thursday 20th August - GCSE

You will be able to collect these, between 8.00am and 10.00am, from the Jubilee Hall.

If you are unable to come in person, you will be able to view your results from 11.00am on the relevant Results Day, by logging into Edulink One using your student login information. Please see the attached document if you are unsure of how to do this.

Please note, due to GDPR, you will be unable to log in using your parent / carer's login credentials.

Alternatively, you may nominate someone to collect the results on your behalf. Please email exams@buckinghamschool.org with your request, stating the full name of the person you have nominated. We will not be able to give your results to anyone without your prior written permission. Written permission cannot be accepted from your parent /carer and must come from you directly.

When you collect your results, there will be members of staff available on the morning to help you with any subject specific queries you may have. Additionally, on both days, there will be staff there to help and advise you with your next steps, should you need it.

Results Reviews and Post-results Services

In early September, each subject area within the School will analyse the results. If you are within 2 marks of the next grade boundary, your subject teacher may feel that it is worth pursuing a review of marking. The first stage in this process is to request your paper; your teacher will then look through your paper to see if they feel that there may be extra marks to be gained. If they do, we can then apply for a review of marking. If they don't, then you may choose to go ahead with a review of marking but this will be at your own expense. Exam Boards set their own fees, but a review of marking is usually in the region of £50 per paper (not per subject).

Please be aware that the School is only able to support Reviews of Marking where you are a maximum of 2 marks away from the next grade boundary. If you are more than 2 marks away from the next grade boundary and still wish to apply for a review of marking, this will also need to be self-funded.

From experience, grades rarely change, however, if your grade does change, the fee will be reimbursed.

You must be aware that once a review of marking has been requested, there is no grade protection and there are three possible outcomes:

- Your original mark is lowered, so your final grade may be lower than the original grade you received.
- Your original mark is confirmed as correct, so there is no change to your grade.
- Your original mark is raised, so your final grade may be higher than the original grade you received

Sixth Form Entry - September 2026

If you have applied for a place in our Sixth for September 2026, a letter, based on your results, will be included in the envelope along with your results. Please ensure that you read this carefully and speak to members of the team if you have any questions. We will have members of our Sixth Form staff and our Senior Leadership Team available for you to talk to. We appreciate that this is an exciting, but also slightly daunting time for you, so do please feel free to come and see us.
